

### **Trailers, Fifth Wheels, Motorhomes, Campers, Tent Trailers & Tents:**

Rigs are restricted to one per site. Secondary units (Campers, Tent Trailers or Tents), to be used by the Site Controllers' teenaged children or grandchildren, will be allowed at the discretion of the Caretakers. They are not intended to be used for second generation families or friends. Our rules permit one person or co-habiting couple as site controllers and one family generation per site. Other overnight visitors, on your site, must sleep in your trailer or motorhome. All secondary units should be removed once the children or grandchildren are no longer teenagers.

For any season, up to ten sites will be designated as 'Two-Rig Sites' and, at the request of the Camper, will be approved on an individual basis. They will be allowed for two generations of one family (who for the most part) camp together. They are not intended to be used as time share sites. Approved sites will be allowed two rigs but will be limited to all other restrictions found throughout Campground Rules, Campground Regulations & Campground Information Sheet. The Caretakers & Director of Property & Maintenance will have the authority to designate such sites after the proper form is forwarded to the Registrar. These sites will pay one and one-half times the published annual site rental rate. Note: Two existing sites have been given a waiver on the two generation requirement.
